We have arranged for the RCAHT archive premises at Unit 8 Canal Basin to be open between 11.00AM and 5.00PM with some car parking available within the canal basin itself. If you need the post code for Sat Nav input it is CV1 4LY

Coventry Museum of Transport (There is no car parking here but it is walkable from the Canal Basin via the footbridge over the Ring Road) with discounted entry for our club members. While you are there you can take the opportunity to walk the Glass Bridge over Lady Herbert's garden.

Riley Rally 30th June 2024 Risk Assessment.

Risk	Mitigation Actions
Vehicle fire	Clear people from surrounding area. 3 certified fire extinguishers will be held on RRSL stand for minor fires only. If not extinguishable easily immediately call Fire Brigade.
Grass fire caused by hot exhaust	Make sure venue has mown the grass prior to event Actions then as above.
Pedestrian collision with vehicle	Enforce 5MPH speed limit on site. Restrict vehicle movements once marshalled into position. Erect signage. Marshals to monitor all vehicle movements to avoid problems arising. For minor injury call onsite first aiders, if serious call 999 immediately.
Visitor feeling unwell	Call onsite first aiders, if the problem looks serious call 999 immediately.
Minor injury event inc burns	First Aid kits to be available on RRSL stand and Rally Control. Call onsite first aiders for assistance.
Potentially uneven surfaces due to past ground work in the field	Rally set up team to monitor. Rope off affected areas, put warning in welcome note(s) and erect signs
Slip risk due to oil spill/leakages	Clean up materials to be available, mandate use of drip tray or mat for leaky vehicles. Put note in rally information sheet. Cover any oil patches with sand available at Rally Control
Fuel misuse and/or ingestion	Ban transfer of fuels inc syphoning other than from containers meeting legal standards, put note in rally information sheet
Eectric shock risks due to need for outdoor PA mains feed esp. if weather is wet	Ensure feed is through an approved RCD device and has a continuous earth connection. If possible use 110V equipment. Keep all connectors in a weatherproof area
Ongoing pandemic if applicable	Request that visitors continue to take precautions. Add request to welcome note(s) Provide hand sanitiser stations.
